Welcome Wagon Fun Sheet





This fun sheet will help you brainstorm creative ways to welcome your new hires. Just work through the questions to gather your thoughts (or use the back of the paper to create your own!).

Does you firm have gift/new hire policies? If so, what your limitations?

Before you begin brainstorming creative ways to welcome your new hire, make sure to check your policies and procedures to see what is allowable.

Do you have a budget for new hire expenses?
